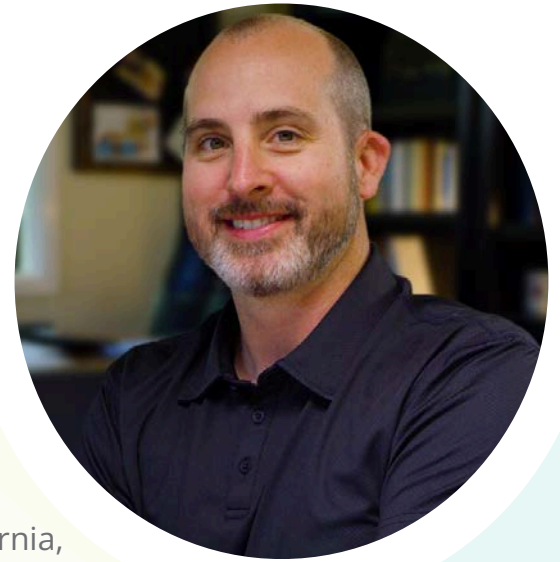

We are also proud to share that we have maintained our commitment to high-quality, transparent stewardship. This year, 88% of every dollar went directly into the programs and services that support our youth and families with only 12% administrative overhead.

Looking ahead, we are excited to embark on our 2026–2028 Strategic Plan, which focuses on expanding our continuum of care and innovating our behavioral health models. This roadmap ensures our teams have the support they need to provide excellence and meet the evolving needs of our communities.

Koinonia's Foster Care Program provides safe, stable homes for children and youth who need consistent care and supportive relationships. Through training, ongoing guidance, and partnership with county and state agencies, we equip families to care for children with diverse needs, including siblings, teens, and youth who require additional therapeutic support.

In California, our services include treatment-based and therapeutic foster care designed to support children within a family setting. In Nevada, our Specialized Foster Care Program serves youth who qualify for treatment-level services and benefit from highly trained foster families supported by a structured clinical model. Across every region, our focus remains the same: strengthening families, promoting permanency, and ensuring children experience safety, stability, and hope.

“Koinonia offers real support—for the whole family. They help build relationships, offer resources, and they never exclude the kids who have already become part of your forever family.

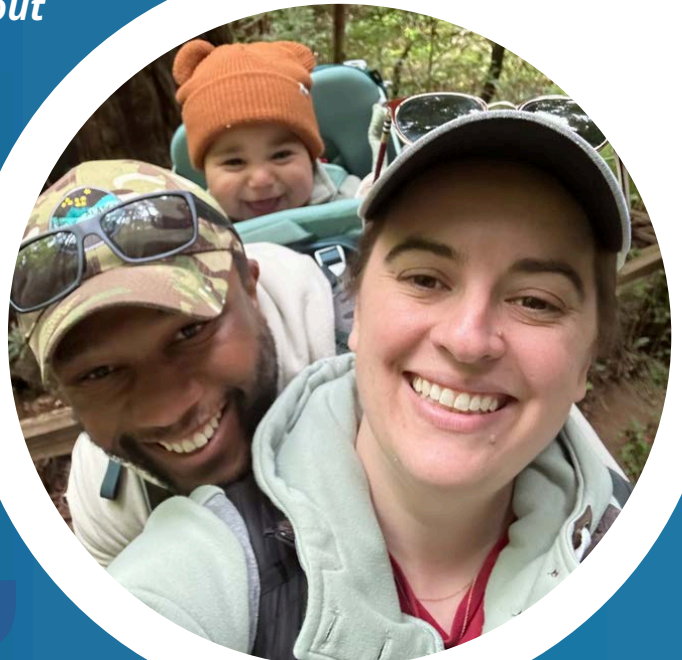
Koinonia's Adoption program supports children and families as they move toward permanency. Whether through adoption through foster care or private domestic adoption services, our team walks alongside families through each step of the process with guidance, preparation, and ongoing support.

In partnership with county and state agencies, we assist resource families in finalizing adoptions for children placed in their homes. Through our private adoption services, we also support birth parents making adoption plans and families growing through adoption across California. At every stage, our focus remains on thoughtful planning, legal integrity, and ensuring children experience the security and belonging of a permanent family.

Koinonia is the reason we have our son today! We had the unique experience of hearing about our son's case through Koinonia. Erin sent us the case and then held our hand from the second we were chosen. She texted us in the hospital and was checking in on us constantly. Post-Adoption Wraparound

Koinonia's Post-Adoption Wraparound program provides team-based, trauma-informed support to adoptive families navigating periods of crisis or instability. Funded through the Adoption Assistance Program, these services are designed to help children remain safely in their homes while strengthening family relationships and stability.

By partnering closely with families and responding flexibly to changing needs, our teams work to preserve permanency and promote long-term well-being.

When families receive the right support at the right time, permanency can be strengthened rather than disrupted.

Enhanced Care Management (ECM), Community Supports, and Community Health Workers, Koinonia's Prevention Services focus on early intervention and whole-person support, helping individuals and families address challenges before they escalate into crisis. Through coordinated care, resource navigation, and community-based partnership, our teams work to promote stability, resilience, and long-term well-being.

ECM provides comprehensive care coordination for individuals with complex medical, behavioral, or social needs. Community Supports address critical factors such as housing stability, while our Community Health Workers serve as trusted guides, helping individuals access services, navigate systems, and overcome barriers to care. Together, these programs create an integrated approach that strengthens families and promotes healthier communities.

Early support can prevent crisis and create lasting stability.

Koinonia's Residential Services, also known as Homes for Teens, provide therapeutic care for adolescents facing significant emotional, behavioral, or mental health challenges. Through our Crisis Resolution Center (CRC), Short-Term and Long-Term Behavioral Health Programs (BHP), and Short-Term Residential Therapeutic Program (STRTP), we offer a range of care designed to meet youth at different levels of need.

Across these programs, youth receive individualized support, clinical care, and consistent guidance within safe, home-like environments. Whether navigating a period of crisis or requiring more structured support, our teams work closely with families and community partners to help youth build coping skills, strengthen relationships, and prepare for successful transitions back to home and community.

At the center of this work is a commitment to creating spaces where youth feel supported, understood, and encouraged as they move forward.

Both CRC and Koinonia genuinely care. They work with anyone who walks through their doors, no matter the challenges, and they never give up. They don't just check a box and move on—they continue to check in, showing consistent, compassionate support. That's what makes this place different. It's more than a shelter or a program—it's a gathering place, a safe haven.



Day Treatment

46 Children and youth supported through our **Day Treatment Program**

Koinonia's Day Treatment Program in Nevada provides after-school therapeutic support for children and teens navigating behavioral and emotional challenges. Serving both pre-adolescent and adolescent youth, the program creates a safe, welcoming space where young people can build coping skills, strengthen peer relationships, and grow in confidence.

Through consistent guidance and collaboration with families and community partners, Day Treatment helps youth stay connected to home and school while gaining the tools they need to manage challenges in healthy and constructive ways.

Learning healthy tools early can reshape a child's path forward.

Outpatient Services

Koinonia's Outpatient Behavioral Health Services provide trauma-informed therapy and mental health support to children, youth, and families in both California and Nevada. Through individualized treatment and collaborative care planning, our clinicians help families navigate emotional, behavioral, and relational challenges with stability and support.

In California, services include specialty mental health support for youth in foster care, residential programs, and post-adoption or guardianship placements, with a strong focus on trauma and permanency-related needs. In Nevada, licensed therapists provide individual, family, and group therapy, including specialized approaches such as EMDR and treatment for youth impacted by trauma. Across both states, our goal is to strengthen families and promote lasting emotional well-being.

Trauma-informed care creates pathways toward stability and healing.

As mental health systems evolve and foster care rate reforms take shape, we will proactively position Koinonia to adapt responsibly, expand services where appropriate, and ensure long-term sustainability.

As regulatory and administrative demands increase, we remain committed to preserving the relational core of our work with children, families, and staff. This strategic plan reflects our belief that growth must be intentional, sustainable, and grounded in connection.
